 - I have been in continuous communication with the Area Treatment Chair, Erik S, and have learned quite a lot about how the Area and Districts are setup to handle treatment opportunities.
 - Traditionally in our Area, the District Treatment chairs have been the primary conduit in handling treatment opportunities within the district boundaries established by the Area (Neta65.org – map)
 - O Going forward, if Intergroup receives a request for bringing meetings into a treatment center, our first course of action will be to reach out to the Area and the specific District that the treatment center is in. This will better serve the treatment centers by promoting neighborhood groups to support those opportunities and, it will better serve the groups immediately surrounding that treatment center by providing easier opportunities for service.
 - If the local district has difficulty fulfilling that need, or that District is inactive for whatever reason, then we'll definitely be announcing those needs to a wider audience if you will.
 - We will still announce service opportunities as they arise, but we'll do that in cooperation with the Area and Districts so that everyone is informed.
